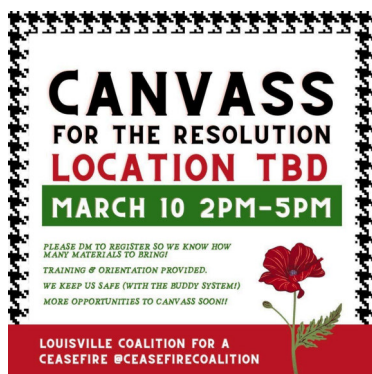
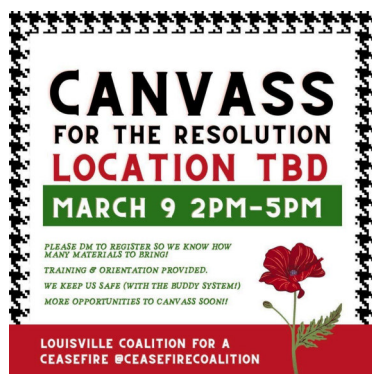

In response to the call from Christian Palestinians and others, walk with us on our waterfront. This Lent, a global movement is walking in prayerful solidarity with the people of Gaza. Come, walk with us. On March 17th, we will walk along the Ohio River in Louisville, Kentucky to simulate the coastline of Gaza, prayerfully asking for 4 things:

- Enduring and Sustained Ceasefire.
- Immediate flow of life saving food, water, aid, fuel and humanitarian assistance.
- Release of all hostages – both the Israeli hostages held by Hamas – and the Palestinian hostages held in the Israeli prison system.
- End of occupation so a just-peace can begin.

This event is in the early planning stages and information will be added as it becomes available.

METRO RESOLUTION CALLS - ALL WEEK EVERY DAY!

✔ **Call the six Committee Members below EVERY DAY before March 6 at their 1:30 meeting** and ask them to “support the Ceasefire Resolution and let it be brought up for a vote by the full Metro council.” Write down seven reasons why you support a ceasefire, and tell the committee member one reason each day that you call them.).

These six people on the Equity Committee will make the decision to either block the resolution or let it be voted on. **Call them EVERY DAY before March 6, even if you are not in their district:**

✔ **Call your own Metro Council representative EVERY DAY before the March 14 Metro Council meeting** and ask them to “cosponsor and vote for the Ceasefire Resolution.” (For example, write down seven reasons why you support a ceasefire, and tell your representative one reason each day that you call them.) ✔ **Attend the March 14 Council meeting. 6:00 Council Chambers. 6th and Jefferson with the clock tower. Come early!**

✔ **Sign the petition to support the Ceasefire Resolution and spread the word!** Post on social media, share in your group chats, and ask your friends, family, coworkers and classmates [to sign and share.](#)

Louisville's Metro Council passed a resolution in 2022 supporting the people of Ukraine, so we know that they understand that their voices can be heard in the name of peace. Let's ask them to do the same for the families in Gaza. Over 40 cities have passed resolutions calling for a ceasefire. **We can make Louisville the next, with your help!**
